NOTICE OF RACE ADDENDUM 2 – IC37 National Championship

1 REGATTA DESIGNATION

This regatta is designated the Melges IC37 National Championship and in accordance with IMIC37 CR H3.2, this event is classified as an A Regatta.

3 CREW WEIGH-INS

- **3.1** There will be no in person crew weigh-ins. Crew weights shall be included in the registration form through Yacht Scoring.
- **3.2** In the event that a skipper of a boat is protested for exceeding the maximum allowable crew weight, he/she shall make all crew weights available prior to the protest hearing and will be required to certify to the accuracy of the data.

4 SCORING

- **4.1** Scoring will be in accordance with IMIC37 CR H3.1. This changes RRS A2.
- **4.2** Friday will not be scored separately.

5 SPECTATOR VESSELS

- 5.1 The following limitations and restrictions apply to team and other spectator vessels.
 - a) Spectator vessels shall not approach closer than 100 meters to any vessel that is racing. In addition, a spectator vessel shall stay at least 100 meters outside any layline and shall not be located directly above any windward marks or the finishing line.
 - b) If in the starting area, spectator vessels shall leave the racing and starting areas prior to the warning signal and may station themselves outside of the starboard end of the starting line, but no closer than 150 meters to the race committee signal vessel.
- **5.2** All team spectator vessels must register with the OA prior to the first day of racing. Team spectator vessels shall display an identifying flag issued by the OA at all times while they are on the water.

6 PRIZES

- 6.1 Prizes for the top five finishing teams will be awarded.
- 6.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA or Class.
