
ROYAL BELGIAN SAILING CLUB

The RBSC was founded in 1863 by a group of people from Ghent who were passionate about the sport of sailing. Club life started on the Lys around five boats. Soon after there were several new units bringing life and development to this new center.

In 1912, the RBSC organized the first sailing regattas on the Terneuzen Canal. These regattas preceded the international rowing regattas of Terdonck, already well known at the time. Since its creation, the club has been particularly



interested in production units (one-designs) and has thus taken a place of choice within the Dutch Belgo League, the body regulating navigation in these two countries.
