2010: 1st Place 2012: 9th Place 2014: 2nd Place 2016: 3rd Place 2018: 3rd Place **CLUB PROFILE:** On March 5, 1870, when yachting in Massachusetts was in its infancy, twelve successful businessmen "imbued with the true yachting spirit," met at John Heard's home; a stately brick mansion on 3 Park Street in Boston, close to the State House with its golden dome and the famous Park Street church. On this evening the gentlemen created and organized themselves as the Eastern Yacht Club for the purpose of encouraging yacht building, naval architecture, and the cultivation of nautical science.

Within a month of meeting, the gentlemen had enrolled 110 members with 23 yachts. Already known as the "Birthplace of the American Navy," Marblehead was chosen for the location of the clubhouse with construction being completed in 1881. Marblehead became the homeport to some of the most beautiful schooners and steamers to be built during this time, establishing itself as 'the yachting capital of the world.'
