

How to Follow the 2022 Resolute Cup

September 12 to 17, Newport, R.I.

"A Corinthian Championship for U.S. Yacht Clubs"

The Resolute Cup is a chance for yacht clubs from across the country to showcase their best amateur talent and celebrate our collective passion for the sport. With provided yachts and sails and standardized rigging, the Resolute Cup represents the most level playing field in sailing. Live multimedia coverage will enable fellow members, friends and family to follow the action as it unfolds on Narragansett Bay.

Racing Schedule, Format, and Location

Overview & Schedule

The 2022 Resolute Cup will be sailed Sept. 12 to 17 in New York Yacht Club's fleet of 23-foot Sonars and a fleet of RS21s provided by RS Sailing. The addition of the RS21 will return the Resolute Cup to its original two-fleet format and ensure that the winning team is truly the best group of sailors on the water.

The 23 teams competing in the 2022 Resolute Cup will arrive on Monday, September 12, for onsite registration and mandatory practice on Tuesday, September 13. Racing is scheduled to run Wednesday, September 14, through Saturday, September 17, starting each day at 1030.

Racing Format

Teams will compete in a qualifying series during the first two days of racing. For the qualifying series, the fleet will be broken into two groups and each group will sail roughly half of its races in the RS21 and half in the Sonar. Teams will be randomly assigned to a boat, and follow a rotation schedule throughout racing each day. There will be no bye races.

After the qualifying series is complete, the top six from each fleet will move on to compete in the Gold Series Finals in RS21s. The remaining teams will compete in the Silver Series Finals in Sonars. Finals will begin on Friday, September 16, and all teams will start with a zeroed-out scoreline.

Racing Location

All racing will take place inside of Narragansett Bay. The primary race area is between Rose Island and Goat Island.

Streaming Video & 3D Tracking

In partnership with Icarus Sports and TracTrac, the final two days of the 2022 Resolute Cup will be broadcast online on Friday, Sept. 16, through Saturday, Sept. 17. Live footage and 2D tracking animation will be accompanied by commentary from sailing experts Andy Green and Francis George. This year, the live broadcast will also feature on-the-water commentary by Katy Nastro. This coverage will be available via the New York Yacht Club Facebook Page and the New York Yacht Club's YouTube Channel.

Crossposting

We welcome yacht clubs and other organizations that would like to crosspost our live coverage on their Facebook pages. This is a great way to spread the race coverage to the followers of each club page. It's more effective than simply sharing the post or video information. The instructions for establishing a crossposting relationship can be found here. Be aware that if you choose to require that crossposted live videos be approved by an admin, you'll need to have someone do that once we start the live video each day. 2D Tracking

Controllable live tracking will be available via the 2022 Resolute Cup website and the <u>event's webpage on TracTrac</u>, as well as on the TracTrac app for <u>iPhones</u>, <u>iPads</u> and <u>Android</u> devices. The 2D tracking will allow fans to follow a specific boat for the duration of the race. The tracking can be replayed anytime following the conclusion of the race.

All race information—including results, race instructions, press releases, etc.—will be accessible via the <u>2022 Resolute Cup webpage</u>. You can also look back at the previous five editions of this premiere event.
