CLUB PROFILE: In June of 1886, a group of local boating enthusiasts joined together to found what has become a cornerstone yacht club in American yachting. San Diego Yacht Club's facilities had humble beginnings in a number of locations, including an old ferry boat.

The racing history of SDYC is as significant as the history of its location. Several members were winning races all over the country in the early to mid-20th century, however, SDYC reached a turning point starting in the 1980s when Dennis Conner won the America's Cup. In the early 1980s, Dennis Conner won the cup once and then lost it in 1983 to the yacht Australia II. In 1987, Dennis won again on behalf of the San Diego Yacht Club. The America's Cup was won a third time by SDYC in 1992 by Bill Koch on the yacht, *America*³.
