Each team must submit the <u>Crew List Form</u> via the online form no later than <u>Friday</u>, <u>July 22</u>. This form captures club membership and sailor classification information for each competitor. Registration will not be considered complete until



all information has been received, checked and verified. Early submissions are encouraged and appreciated.

WORLD SAILING CATEGORIZATION

Per NOR 1.3, all competitors shall be classified as Group 1. Those without a classification or with an expired classification will not be eligible to sail. Click here to obtain or renew your World Sailing categorization. Each sailor's categorization is due July 22 as part of the Crew List. If you do not have a current categorization and have not yet started the process, we suggest you do so immediately. It can take a while to complete!
