REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

- _____ Lifebuoy with Drogue, or Life Sling without Drogue, with yacht name
- _____ Heaving Line of Length 15m-25m
- _____ 3 Forward Halyards
- ____ Cockpit Knife
- _____ Bilge Pump Handles with Lanyards
- _____ Manual Bilge Pump (Category 5)
- ____ Companionway Hatch Securely Attached
- _____ 2 Buckets with Lanyards (minimum 2.4 US Gallons)
- _____ VHF Radio
- ____ Emergency Antenna
- _____ Radio Receiver capable of receiving weather bulletins
- _____ Wood Plugs by all Through-Hull Openings
- _____ 2 Fire Extinguishers
- Anchor, Chain and Rode 16 Kg. Minimum Weight; shall be stored aft of the engine and ready for immediate use (Class Rule 21.3.3). Except when in the process of being deployed, the anchor cannot be moved during racing.
- _____ Emergency Tiller secured and carried on the port side in the aft lazarette
- _____ First Aid Kit with Manual
- ____ Foghorn
- _____ Radar Reflector
- ____ Paper Charts
- _____ Ship's or Handheld Compass (Category 5)

MODIFICATION TO EQUIPMENT CARRIED ONBOARD

Swan 42 Class Association Rule 21.3 is changed for this regatta as follows:

- 21.3.1 The door separating the main salon from the fore cabin may be removed from the yacht during racing.
- 21.3.2 The cushions and movable wooden berth structure in the fore cabin may be removed from the yacht during racing.
