



ORC INFORMATION

For the 2020 sailing season, New York Yacht Club will be incorporating the ORC rating rule into the Leukemia Cup, 166th Annual Regatta, Race Week at Newport presented by Rolex and the Queen's Cup. In anticipation for the ORC/IRC World Championship in September, this rule will be run in conjunction with IRC and scoring will be done as a combination of both. While a fully measured ORC International, and an IRC Endorsed certificate will be required for the Worlds, ORC Club and IRC (un-endorsed) certificates will be accepted for all other events.

The Offshore Racing Congress (ORC) is offering complementary ORC Club certificates to boats with current IRC or ORR certificates, and to PHRF boats with appropriate sail measurement certificates. These certificates will be valid for 2020.

The complementary ORC certificates will be issued by US Sailing and are offered under the following conditions:

- Available only to boats who have not been issued an ORC certificate in the past 5 years;
- This complementary offer only applies to ORC Club certificates only, not to ORCi or ORC DH;
- Recipients must be members of US Sailing;
- Sail measurements must be provided (on the forms attached) to the US Sailing Offshore office: offshore@ussailing.org;
- Applicants will use this link to order and specify the Promotion Code **NYYC2020**: www.ussailing.org/competition/offshore/request-a-rating;

Boats with recent IRC or ORR certificates will have sufficient data to quickly receive a valid ORC Club certificate from US Sailing but please allow 5-7 days after applying. Boats needing an ORC DH certificate should first apply to get an ORC Club or ORCi certificate (without the promotion code) then request US Sailing to also issue a valid ORC DH certificate at no additional fee.
